Ethical Business Policy includes Modern Slavery & Human Trafficking Statement

Alongside our environmental policy and personnel procedures is our ethical policy. The preservation of a reputation for integrity and fair dealing is of paramount importance to our company. In addition to the above and with regard to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, P&A Transport (Sweepers) Limited have a published statement of the steps we take to understand and therefore minimise the potential risk of modern slavery in our business and in our supply chain.

We are committed to the principles of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and encourage staff to report any concerns without any risk to themselves.

Our business recruitment process include due diligence of the prospective employees right to work in the UK and to protect staff in our employment from discrimination, coercion or abuse.

Our business would not knowingly enter into business with any company or organisation found to be involved in slavery or human trafficking.
